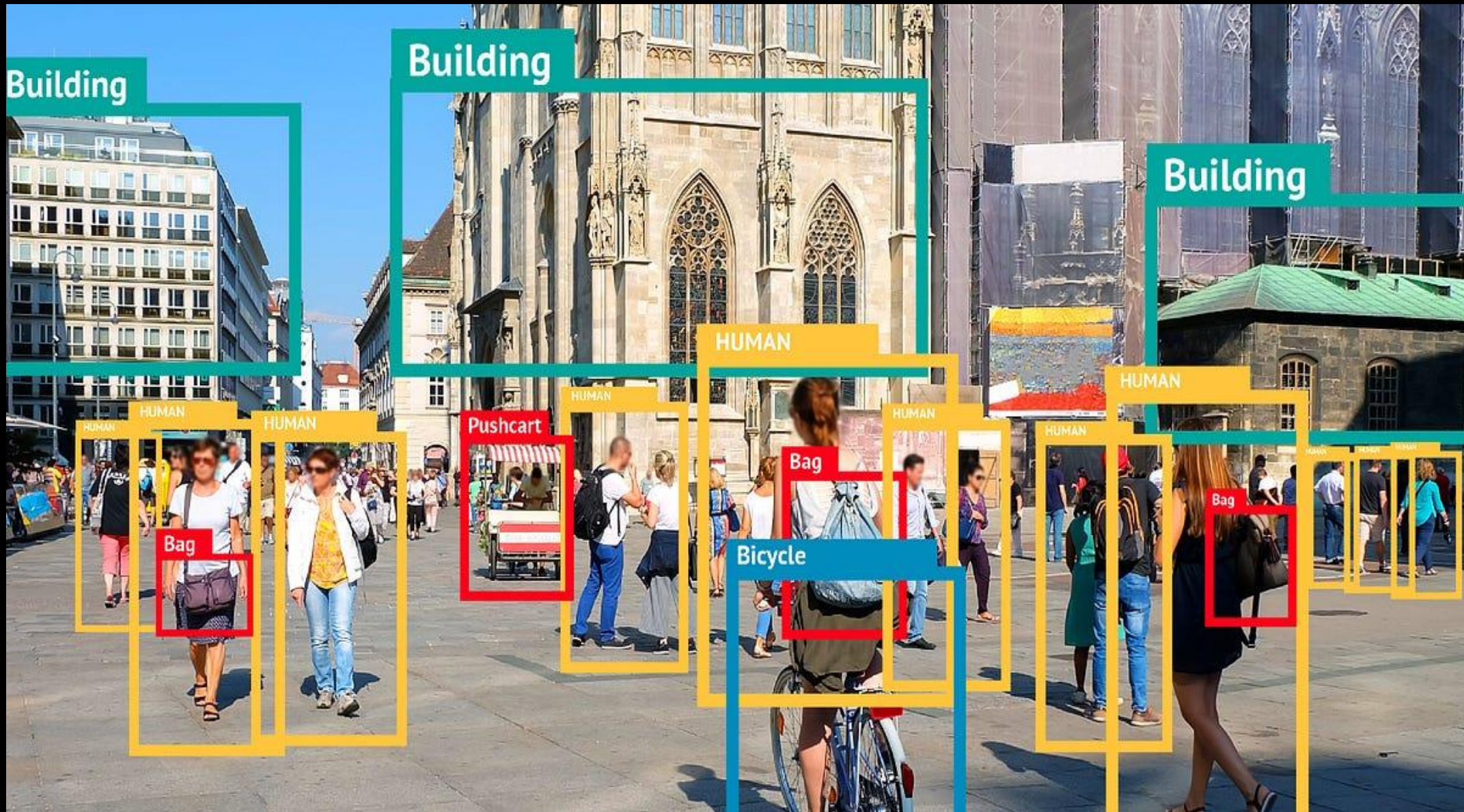

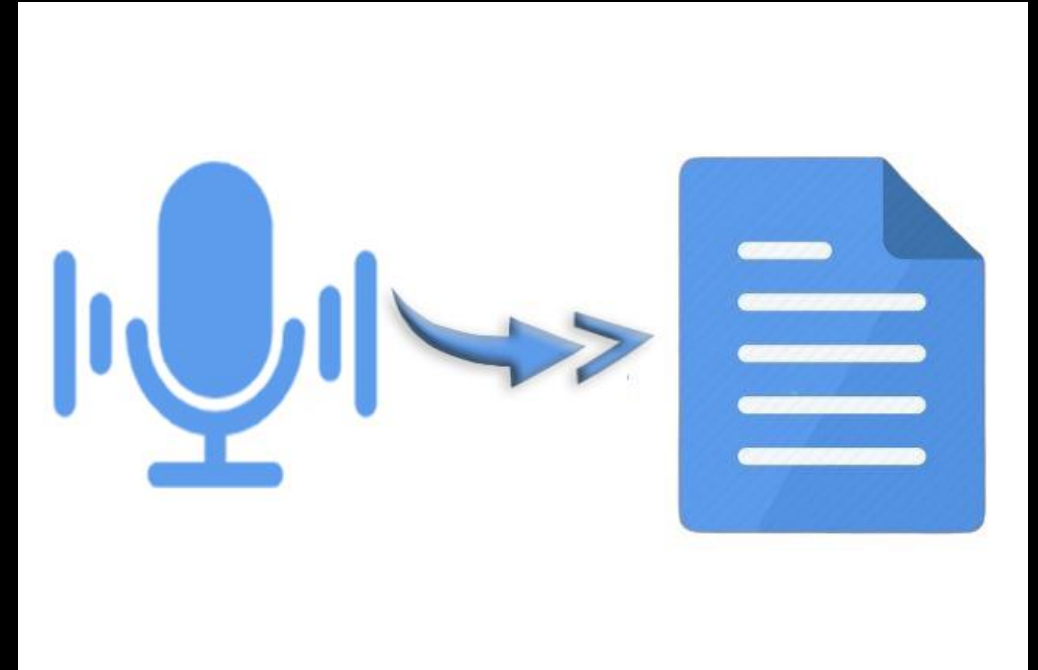

Automate Interview Transcriptions: Low Risk?

- 1h audio = 11-13h human transcription work!
- 27 min audio ~ 45sec with Automated Speech Recognition!

LONDON, Jan 10 (Reuters) - One of Britain's biggest miscarriages of justice, the wrongful conviction of hundreds of [Post Office workers](#) due to faulty software, has exploded into the public domain following a TV drama, triggering demands for justice.

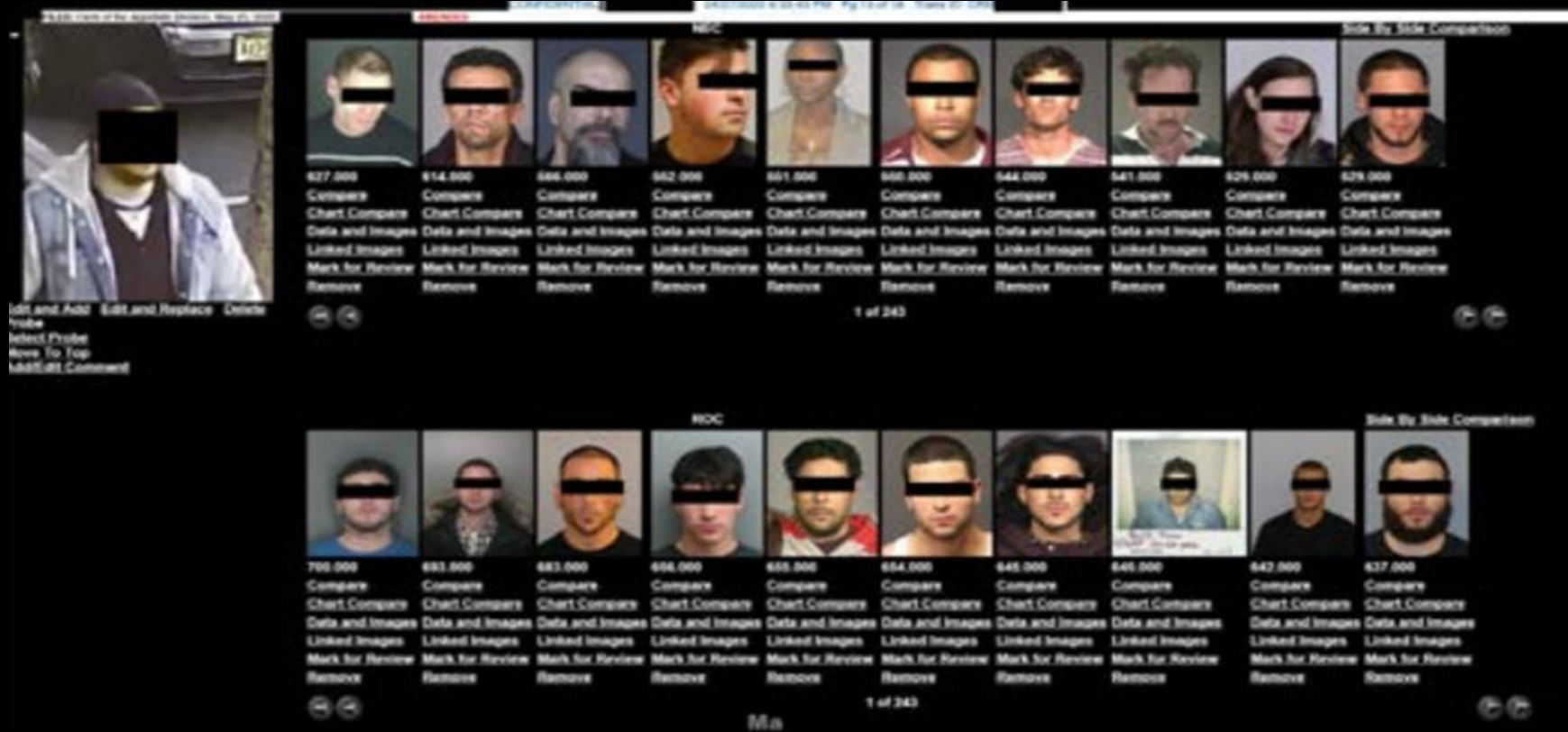

Cyber-investigation: Implementation of a data capture technique
Criminal cases open in France and several countries
Joint Investigation Team (JIT) with EUROJUST and EUROPOL
Drug trafficking and Weapon trafficking

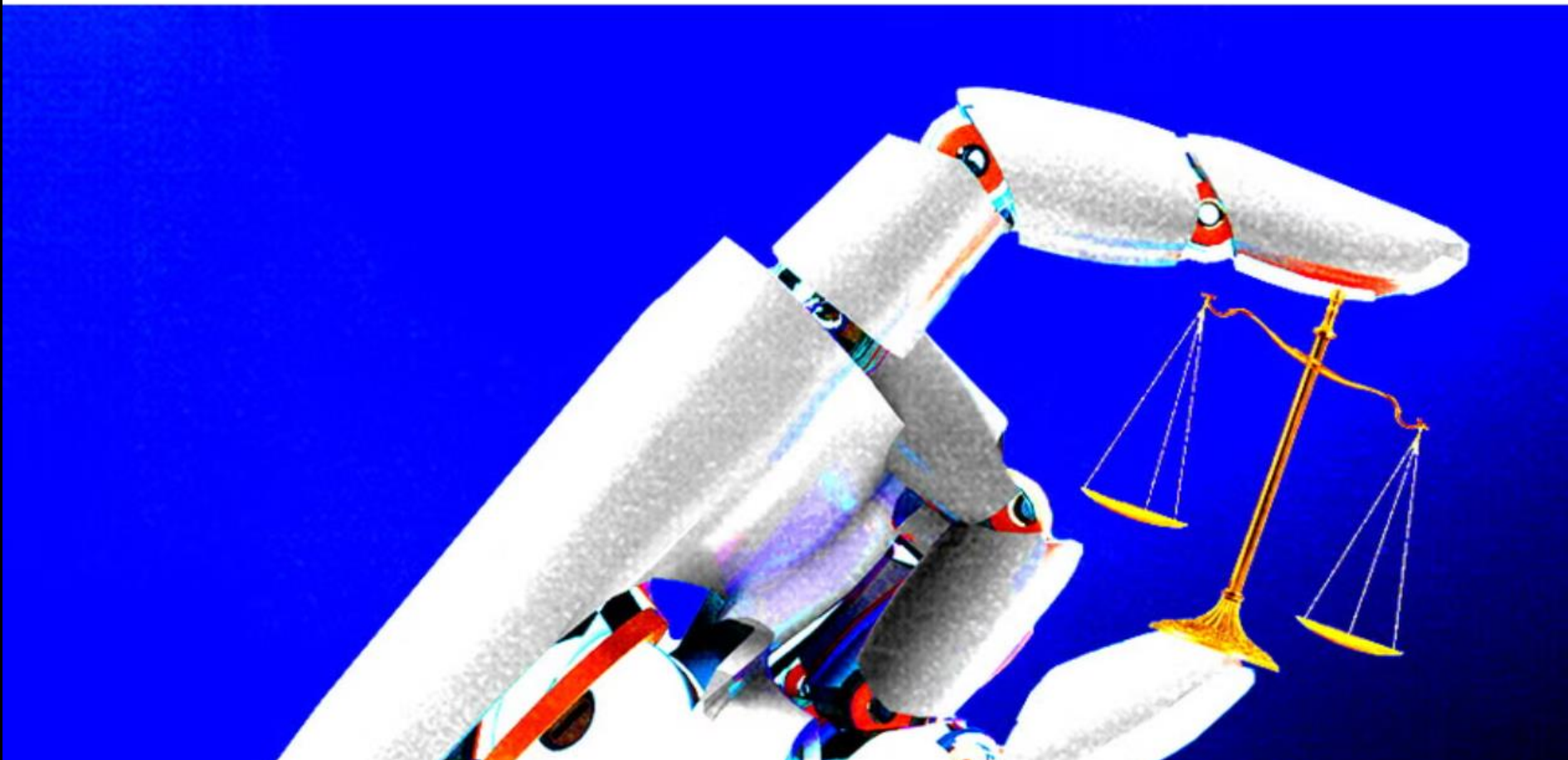


A screenshot of the DataWorks Plus Case Management interface, showing two algorithms run concurrently. (Source: Hudson County, NJ Prosecutor's Office)

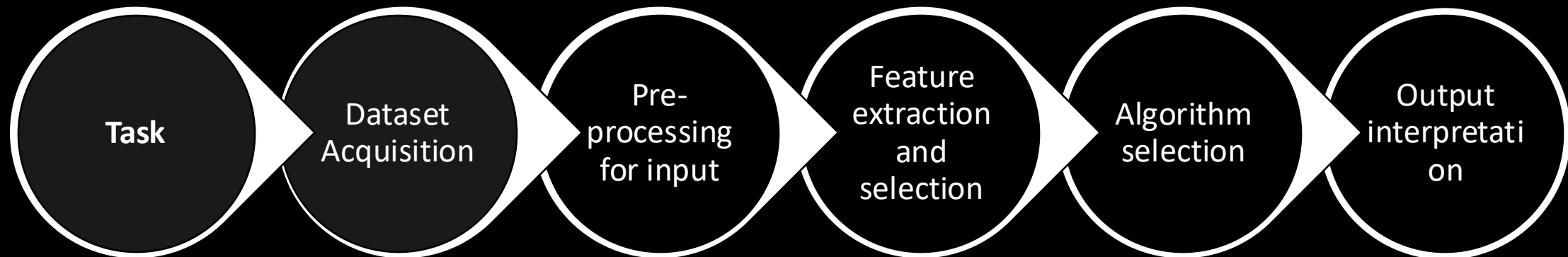

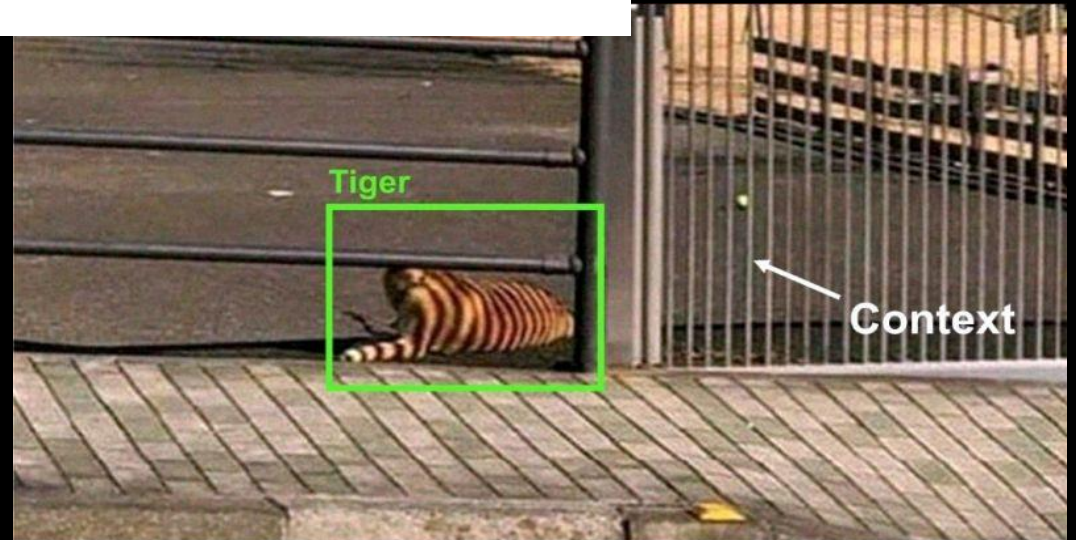

A digital right to procedural accuracy?

- *Status negativus*: Protection against unreliable digital evidence processing
- *Status positivus*: Access, explanation, and forensic assistance
 - Right to access to the chain of custody
 - Right to explanation of methods and results
 - Access to digital forensics assistance
- *Status activus*: The right to participate in **determinative stages** of digital evidence processing

AI for forensics – it is not just about AI system design, but also:

- **Novel interpretation of digital forensics standards in AI context**
- **Procedural safeguards**
- **Active defence rights!**
